There are a number of programs and events designed to inform, educate, stimulate, and elate.

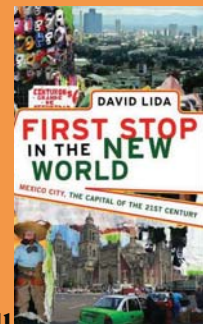
